





Worcester's historic, scenic and evocative public cemetery is the largest facility of its kind in the eastern part of Otsego County. Since its formation in 1864, it has expanded to the present 24 acres and has been the host of the annual Memorial Day observances, and of other public gatherings. The town's founders, early settlers, veterans of all the nation's conflicts since the Revolution, civic leaders and other notable citizens, rest here.

With this prominence and growth have come problems of financial and material support. The cemetery trustees are limited in their legal ability to ask for funding. So later this year, a new federally- and state-recognized non-profit group will form, open to everyone who would like to help with fund-raising, supplemental upkeep and support, increasing public information and interest in the cemetery, reviewing plans, and suggesting projects and improvements.

There is also a need for people who may have the skills and interest in managing or performing the regular daily work of cemetery maintenance. Anyone who would like to take part in this Friends organization, or to assist in cemetery management, may contact any of these cemetery trustees.


Public Notice



The objective of the meeting is to raise questions and talk with each other about drilling for gas in Worcester, Otsego County and New York State. Since our Town Meeting a year ago, much has happened and much has been learned about hydraulic fracturing (fracking). It is becoming increasingly clear that this issue will greatly affect most, if not all, of the people of Worcester. If Worcester is fracked like western Pennsylvania, it will change the character of Worcester - from the values of its homes to its attractiveness for tourists and newcomers.

There are many decisions that will be made this year about how, and how much, the gas companies will be regulated - from protecting our roads and public waters to how the thousands of tanker loads of spent fracking fluids will be stored and/or transported and treated.

We invite you to share your concerns and ideas about these and other issues with the intention of enabling the citizens of Worcester to be heard and have a say in this issue and our shared future. We believe the answers to how to proceed should come from the people who will live with the consequences and not from the oil companies and their allies.

This meeting is about hearing from the people and not about giving a platform to either antidrilling or pro-drilling "experts." There have been many opportunities to read and hear those positions. Now is the time to discuss and have a voice in the choices that will affect not only us. but also our children.







I Don't Understand...

- 1) Why anti-gas drillers would be happy that the medical staff at Bassett commented on "threats to the health of patients due to hydro-fracturing," when doctors continue to write prescriptions that have side effects of seizures, heart attacks, liver damage and possible death to thousands of patients.
- 2) Why some anti-gas drillers think it is OK to smoke, cause pollution and harm to those around them that don't smoke, and have hospital beds occupied with patients with emphysema, heart disease and lung cancer. And yet everyone has to pay those medical expenses.
- 3) Why some people worry about the existence of wildlife, but still hunt and kill them.
- 4) Why people use wood burning stoves and continue to cut down trees when there are more respiratory diseases in children caused by wood stoves than in gas drilling.
- 5) Why some anti-gas drillers don't believe that rusted, inoperable machinery and appliances on private properties are causing soil and water contamination and air pollution. Are they kidding? And then there's always the disgusting trash that is thrown along the roads and in the creeks. Many people here already don't drink their well water because of the presence of coliform, sulfur, methane and other minerals in their water.
- 6) Why environmentalists protested against pipeline construction in Alaska with the fear of ruining forests and killing the animal population, and yet Alaskan forests are still thriving beautifully and there are more elk and caribou now than before the pipeline.
- 7) Why anti-gas drillers don't acknowledge there are diesel truck accidents that have polluted the air, soil and water, or that diesel is a source of benzene contamination, and yet we still use diesel.
- 8) Why people complain about highway destruction from gas drilling trucks when the highways are already full of pot holes.
- 9) Why anti-gas drillers don't reference a report from the Task Force, with the Bipartisan Policy Center, and American Clean Skies Foundation which consists of environmental experts, electric utilities, public utility regulators, industrial consumers, consumer advocates, gas companies, and financial analysts.
- 10) Why anti-gas drillers don't have a problem with driving automobiles or using nylon, laundry detergent, paint or glue, when all these products, and others, contain by-products of natural gas. Even electricity and wind turbines need natural gas.
- 11) Why environmentalists would Not want oil refineries and gas drilling in the U.S., where there are environmental regulations, but would rather have drilling companies go to countries where there are not regulations and have our tax money go to those other countries.
- 12) Why people can't accept differing views in a respectable and non-violent manner.

But just so people don't think I can't understand things, I do understand fear of everyday living. Every day there is a possibility of car, truck, plane and train accidents. Walking across a street and getting killed by a vehicle. But do we stop using this transportation? Occasional auto recalls. Do we stop manufacturing them?

Oil spills, mining tragedies, but we still use oil and coal. Soldiers get killed for our democracy. Should we cease having a military? Farm animals fecal material pollutes streams and water wells. Should we ban farming and get milk and beef from foreign countries?

Please say No!

We eat fruits and vegetables knowing they are covered with pesticides. We kill fish to eat them. Oil/gas spills kill fish accidentally. The waters get cleaned, the fish keep populating and they're still in abundance. Mouthwash is supposed to kill germs, but the back label states, "call your poison control center if you swallow more than the recommended dosage." That's scary.

There are more health related incidents and hospitalizations due to everyday living. But to say gas drilling is more harmful to people and the environment...very inaccurate. And noise and air pollution are Not every hour, every day, all year in gas drilling. "Of all fossil fuels, natural gas burns the cleanest and is the most environmentally friendly. It has less sulfur, nitrogen, carbon and pollution than coal or petroleum." "The Chinese were piping natural gas 2500 years ago and burning it to evaporate sea water for salt."

I understand the status quo...continued unemployment, food prices increasing, rising prices at the gas pumps and heating fuel, property taxes rising, and all with no additional income to keep up with the rising expenses. But to hear statements that tourism and real estate values have decreased because of gas drilling...quite incorrect. As well knows, both of those areas have been hit hard the past few years due to the economic turmoil, not gas drilling. To the contrary, real estate values have greatly increased in drilling areas. Ghost towns as a result of drilling? I don't know where. But there will be ghost towns if revenue is prevented and people continue to move to other towns that are more prosperous with lower property taxes and fuels costs. Some states where there is gas drilling have no sales tax, and some have a property tax limit that won't increase after age 65.


Yes, I understand property rights, Constitutional right to own guns, of which guns harm more people than gas drilling. So if people can smoke and own guns, while harming others and the environment, why can't people have the right to lease their land for mineral rights to get themselves out of debt, create jobs (even a few are a blessing), pay off their homes and farm equipment to avoid foreclosures? Revenue to the communities to keep down taxes. Even short term is better than none.

Monitoring by national and state environmental personnel would assure proper procedures are followed in responsible gas drilling. Gas companies have also completely repaired highways and planted trees at their own expense. Will accidents happen? Yes, in any aspect of life, accidents will occur and cause damage, but we can't crawl in a hole and stop living. Much progress has been made in drilling methods to reduce chemical usage with more "green" methods and much safer removal of any waste. New cleaner drilling procedures are being used that greatly minimize the use of water and chemical waste resulting in a large reduction of truck traffic. Water contamination in the U.S. has been extremely minimal for nearly 200 years of gas drilling, with remedies made, as opposed to continued contamination and pollution by the actions of individuals.

As reported through the Task Force with the Bipartisan Policy Center, and American Clean Skies Foundation: "American natural gas is a winning proposition for consumers, America's economy, the environment, our nation's energy security." Also reported is "more water is used to water a golf course than in hydro-fracturing a well, and more water is used by a power plant."

I take personal pride in researching factual bipartisan information, rather than using scare tactics with words as "possible," "chance" and "potential." I believe it is better for everyone to be bipartisan and truthful, and work together, rather than be one-sided and report inaccurate information.

Trails in the Wilderness - the influence and impacts of missionaries in the area in the period from 1790 to 1805.


